- **Important PSAT Information.** PSATs are this Wednesday. All students must bring 2 #2 pencils AND their calculator to Wednesday's testing. It is crucial that all students in grades 8-11 are on time to school for PSAT testing. Students who show up late and delay testing in one homeroom, affects all homerooms as we are not allowed to release any testing room until every student has completed testing. If a student arrives after testing has begun, they will not be allowed to test--so it is imperative that students get to school on time. Also, Wednesday is a 1:15 pm dismissal. Unless students are staying after for athletics or play practice, all students must be off school grounds no later than 2:00 pm. Please make plans to pick up your student by that time.
