Tickets are \$10 per person. Tickets are on sale on school days between Monday, November 18th and Friday, December 6. Tickets **MAY NOT** be purchased at the door. The doors are closed at 8 PM and students must sign out if they depart early. Once they have left the dance, they may not return.

There will be a lighted arch in the foyer for a photo opportunity for all students. Parents wishing to take advantage of this should be here from 7-8 PM. After this time only parents approved as chaperones should be on-site.

Non-PC guests invited to the dance must be under 21 and of the opposite sex. A Special Guest Permission Form must also be signed by both sets of parents or guardians and returned to the main office by Friday, December 6- No exceptions!.
