### EISTC Funding Preserved

Thank you for responding to our request to rally for our legislators to support the Education Improvement Scholarship Tax Credits. The full funding was



retained on a bi-partisan vote in both the House of Delegates and the Senate. Let me assure you that this happened only because Virginians like you took action to let your elected officials know your views. Thank you for helping us to provide this much needed assistance for our PC students.

If your student had medication in the clinic contact **Ms. Silcox** (school nurse) to arrange for a pick up time. Any medication that is not picked up by **June 30th** will be disposed of accordingly.

### Is Your Student Current on All Vaccinations?

In the coming months, we encourage you to make an appointment with your student's health care provider to get your student's vaccinations completed if you have not done so already. Encourage

your student's health care provider to use the Virginia Immunization Information System and any vaccination records you have for your child to determine which vaccines your student may need. If your student does not have a healthcare provider, please contact your local health department to determine if your student is eligible to receive vaccinations at the health department. Local health department contact information can be found [here](#).



Please be aware that each school year, your student's vaccination records will be reassessed to ensure that he/she is sufficiently vaccinated. If sufficient documentation is not submitted to Ms. Silcox, School Nurse, for your student, he/she might be required to stay home from school until proper documentation is provided.

Rising Seniors are required to have at least one dose of Meningococcal Vaccine (effective date July 1, 2021) A 12th grader will need a menACWY dose at 16 years or older regardless if they had one previous dose before 16 years old.
