Is Your Student Current on All Vaccinations?

In the coming months, we encourage you to make an appointment with your student's health care provider to get your student's vaccinations completed if you have not done so already. Encourage your student's health care provider to use the Virginia Immunization Information System and any vaccination records you have for your child to determine which vaccines your student may need. If your student does not have a healthcare provider, please contact your local health department to determine if your student is eligible to receive vaccinations at the



health department. Local health department contact information can be found here.

Please be aware that each school year, your student's vaccination records will be reassessed to ensure that he/she is sufficiently vaccinated. If sufficient documentation is not submitted to Ms. Silcox, School Nurse, for your student, he/she might be required to stay home from school until proper documentation is provided.

Rising Seniors are required to have at least one dose of Meningococcal Vaccine (effective date July 1, 2021) A 12th grader will need a menACWY dose at 16 years or older regardless if they had one previous dose before 16 years old.

If you have any questions regarding vaccinations, feel free to contact Ms. Silcox.




Calendar for 2022-23 School Year
