The time is finally here! You <u>MUST</u> turn in your Continuous Enrollment Contract in order to secure your students' space at PCHS.


The Continuous Enrollment Registration Fee will be billed to you (after we have received your signed contract) unless you completed an Opt Out Form for the 22-23 school year.

After April 15: All Opt-Out requests will forfeit the \$150 non-refundable registration fee and be assessed a tuition penalty April 15-June 30: 20% tuition penalty July 1 and later: 100% tuition penalty
