The following reminder was given to all students last week:

Wearing a face mask in the building is not only a diocesan policy it is also a *Public Health Order*. Students must have their mouth and nose covered from the time they enter the building until the time they leave it, with the exception of when they are allowed mask breaks in classes and when they are eating lunch. They may not have their masks down in any communal area at any time--hallways, bathrooms, at Mass, etc. While we are all weary of this, there does not appear to be an end in sight at this time. Please be reminded that students can receive 5 demerits for this infraction and may even be asked to move to virtual learning after repeated infractions. Your support by reminding your student to follow a *Public Health Order* is greatly appreciated.


