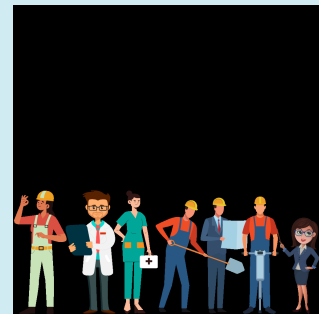

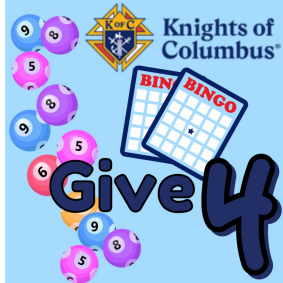
Cafeteria help needed
