- **"Knights Fitness Challenge"**

Knights are known for their bravery! You all have shown just how brave and resilient we PC Knights are! We are asking all students, families, faculty, and staff to join us in our Knights Fitness Challenge! Step into your future with a healthy body! It's Easy!! Just record your daily steps!! (On Your Honor!)

Challenge Rules:

Move 2000 steps a day (one mile) and earn points for you and your class!! The more steps you take a day, the more points you and your class receive! Prizes will be awarded to an individual student from each grade level, one family, one staff member and one teacher at the end of the Challenge! The winning class will receive Chalice Points!

You can track your steps on your phone, watch or an app of your choice. Record your steps daily for the next four weeks beginning Monday, April 27th. You will record your total steps for the week on [This Spreadsheet!](#) (Be sure you record it on the correct tab at the bottom.) We will complete the challenge on Friday, May 22nd!

500 steps = 1/4 mile

1000 steps = 1/2 mile

1500 steps a day = 3/4 mile

2000 steps a day = 1 mile (Minimum steps per day for points)

10,000 steps a day = 5 miles
