- Virtual College Workshop Coming this Tuesday, September 1. Join Mr. Batkin for our annual College Workshop for Senior families on Tuesday, September 1 at 6:30 pm. - Update from Last Week and Minor Changes in Dismissal. Thanks to the efforts of the PC Staff and Faculty and the students who carefully observed and followed all the new policies and guidelines with careful observance, we had a great first week! Thanks also to all the carpool parents who smoothly transitioned into the new drop off and pick up procedures. One reminder, one clarification and one change:
  - Please do not leave until you see your student checked in and on their way into the building;
  - When picking up, you may choose either line--either the one on the right (as you enter) that wraps around the side parking lot OR the shorter line on the left. It DOES NOT matter which lane you use--pick up is not based on Grade Level it is based on keeping the carpool lines moving. As the cars in front of you exit, please pull up--but please do not block the pedestrian crossing.
  - In an effort to keep our student drivers safe as they exit the building, they will be dismissed first at 2:20 (or 2:00 on Mondays) followed by carpool students at 2:23 (or 2:03 on Mondays).
