News and Announcements

- **Binding Grades/Integrated Honors.** Tuesday marks the 5 week point of the term, which we call "Binding Grades." This is the checkpoint to review student eligibility for extracurricular and athletic eligibility. This is also the point where students interested in taking a course for integrated honors would find out if they qualified. Please review your student's grades to see where they are and feel free to reach out to their teachers or their counselors should you have any questions or concerns.
- Are you interested in a \$2,000 tuition credit? Current families may refer up to 2 new students each school year (maximum of \$2,000) through the New Student Referral Program. New students may be from any school EXCEPT Our Lady of Mount Carmel, Saint Mary Star of the Sea School or Portsmouth Catholic Regional School to be eligible under this program. New students must be enrolled at the beginning of each term and attend classes for one month prior to award distribution. For more information please contact Mrs. LeMaster.

- All students--virtual and on campus--in grades 8-11 will have their pictures taken Tuesday, October 6. Everyone will get their pictures taken and then the studio will send a packet of proofs to the school to be distributed to your student. (We will let you know when this happens.) After reviewing the proofs and deciding what package you want, you may either send in the order form with a check with your student or order directly online--which is the easiest option. When the pictures come in, they will be delivered to each homeroom.

Appointment Times for Virtual Students: Virtual students may make an appointment between 7:50AM and 9:00 AM using <u>this form</u>. Students who are unable to come to this portrait sitting or the makeup sitting on November 17 will be "Not Pictured" but will have their name in the yearbook.

Students in grades 8-11 may wear the following:
