The Office of Catholic Schools announced all schools will be adjusting a few days off in our school calendar. The last day of each grading quarter will now be a full day off for students. This will allow for the schools to conduct a quarterly deep cleaning and to give the teachers, administrators, and staff a small, but well-deserved break. End of quarter dates when school will be closed are as follows: October 23, 2020, January 15, 2021, March



19, 2021, and June 4, 2021. The final day of school for students will now be **June 3, 2021.** For Peninsula Catholic, this means mid-terms will be moved to October 21 and 22. The online calendar has been updated to reflect these changes. Thank you for your continued Support.

During midterm examinations our usual cafeteria service is suspended. Lunches on these days, Wednesday October 21, 2020 and Thursday October 22, 2020, will only be available by advanced order. No other food will be served on these days. The Deadline for online orders is Tuesday, October 20, 2020. The cost will \$5.00 per meal. In previous years you would need to order from the school website. This year you will order the Exam day Lunch the same way you order your student's everyday lunch through FACTS Family.



Applications are now open for the 21-22 school year! Current families may refer up to 2 new students each school year (maximum of \$2,000) through the New Student Referral Program. New students may be from any school EXCEPT Our Lady of Mount Carmel, Saint Mary Star of the Sea School or Portsmouth Catholic Regional School to be eligible under this program.
