--**Ladies:** Dress slacks or skirt and modest blouse or dress (skirt and dress should be no shorter than the top of the knee), dress shoes. Moderate and appropriate jewelry and make-up.

Students who do not wish to dress up in the manner just outlined are required to be in forum dress instead.

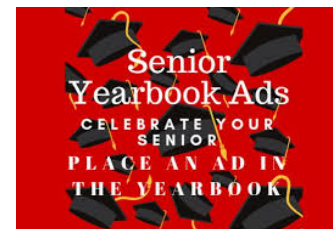
A **Letter from the school nurse**. Stay safe and healthy this upcoming Flu season.
