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Tuition rates include General Fees (curriculum, technology, activities, retreats, student insurance, Home and School membership for Host Families, and athletic fees), one yearbook, and Chroomebook Insurance.

ADDITIONAL FEES

- \$100 registration fee per family per year (separate from application fee).
- \$500 deposit for new families, applied to tuition.
- \$500 one-time facilities fee for new families.
- \$125 graduation fee for rising seniors.

OTHER COSTS

- Certain classes (Art, Photography, Advanced Placement Exams, etc.)
 have additional course and exam fees.
- Books are approximately \$250 per semester
- Uniforms, purchased through Land's End, are approximately \$150 to \$200.

DISCOUNTS

- Multiple Student Discount: 10% for 2nd student.
 5% for additional students.
- Active Duty Military families are eligible for a 5% tuition discount.
- Referral Discount: refer a new family from a non-feeder school to PCHS and receive a \$1,000 credit on tuition. Maximum of 2 referral discounts per family, per year.
