Students who are currently virtual learners may return to on-campus learning for Term 2, beginning Wednesday, January 20, 2021. In order to plan for both on-campus and virtual learners, parents must contact their student's counselor, Dan Batkin or Candice Strickland, no later than Tuesday, January 12 to make this change. The last day to switch will be Friday, January 22, 2021. The next opportunity for a switch would be at mid-

term, Thursday, March 18. At that time, students will remain as virtual or on-campus learners for the remainder of the year. These same dates apply for moving from on-campus to virtual learning.

During final examinations, our usual cafeteria service is suspended. Lunches on these days, Wednesday, January 13, 2021, and Thursday, January 14, 2021, will only be available by advanced order. Tuition rates include General Fees (curriculum, technology, activities, retreats, student insurance, Home and School membership for Host Families, and athletic fees), one yearbook, and Chroomebook Insurance.		

ADDITIONAL FEES

- \$100 registration fee per family per year (separate from application fee).
- \$500 deposit for new families, applied to tuition.
- \$500 one-time facilities fee for new families.
- \$125 graduation fee for rising seniors.

OTHER COSTS

- Certain classes (Art, Photography, Advanced Placement Exams, etc.)
 have additional course and exam fees.
- Books are approximately \$250 per semester
- Uniforms, purchased through Land's End, are approximately \$150 to \$200.

DISCOUNTS

- Multiple Student Discount: 10% for 2nd student.
 5% for additional students.
- Active Duty Military families are eligible for a 5% tuition discount.
- Referral Discount: refer a new family from a non-feeder school to PCHS and receive a \$1,000 credit on tuition. Maximum of 2 referral discounts per family, per year.
