Open Positions for 21-22. This year, our faculty is stretched about as thin as can be due to the unexpected number of late enrollments throughout the year. New Immunization schedule change for the 2021-2022 School year. The new legislation change will require Two (2) properly spaced doses of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MenACWY). The first dose shall be administered prior to the 7th grade. The second dose shall be administered prior to the 12th grade. Two (2) properly spaced doses of the Hepatitis A vaccine will be required for Kindergarten schoolentry. Students in Grades 1 & above will be considered grandfathered regarding the Hepatitis A vaccine. More

To ALL Parents/Guardians: This bears repeating, Whenever your student is Absent, whether VIRTUALLY or ON CAMPUS, we need an email stating the REASON for the absence.
