Mrs. Franklin Challenges the Students for Operation Rice Bowl! Each Tuesday and Thursday, we have been collecting donations for our Lenten almsgiving to Operation: Rice Bowl. Operation Rice Bowl provides lifesaving support for 159 million people--many of whom are children--in over 100 countries, including the United States. So far we have only collected \$219.72. That is about 81 cents a student. We have two more collection days--Tuesday, and Holy Thursday. Mrs. Franklin has challenged each student to give \$1 to Operation Rice Bowl this week. If we reach \$400 by Holy Thursday, Mrs.

Franklin will donate another \$50 to the Rice Bowl. If you would like to donate as a family, it would be most welcome.

Any hours not served by Monday, May 31, 2021, will be assessed \$15 per hour for uncompleted time. An outstanding balance will preclude the
