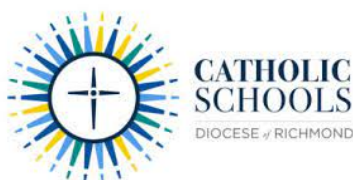


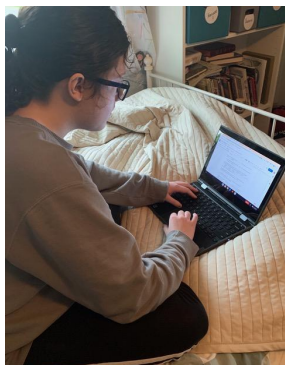

Declaration of In-Person or Virtual Instruction 21-22 School Year.

As we conclude the second term and prepare for a well-deserved summer break, our counselors are busy finalizing classroom logistics for the upcoming school year.

As you are aware, PCHS will be offering two learning options for students which include a traditional in-person instructional model or a virtual synchronous instructional model. As a reminder, students that choose to learn virtually are still able to come to campus to participate in extracurriculars, athletics, and social events.

We know that restrictions are ever-changing, but in order to plan accordingly for the upcoming year, we need to know what your initial plans are by June 3, 2021. You *will* have an opportunity to change your decision as we get closer to the start of the school year.

REMINDER! Students who have **not** contracted for the 2021-2022 school year and International students are required to turn in their Chromebook and their charger on the last day of school, June 3, 2021. Students who do not turn in their Chromebook and/or chargers have one week until their parents are charged \$275 for both pieces of equipment; students with missing charging cords only will be charged \$20. Once a student is reenrolled and the financial contract is signed their Chromebook will be returned.



All rising 9th and 11th graders will be turning in their Chromebooks for the summer to their homeroom teachers, as they will be receiving new Chromebooks prior to the start of the next school year. You will receive your new Chromebooks in the Main Office between mid-July and

August 20. If you do not pick them up at that time, you will not receive them until the first week of school.



Attention: The due to our exam day schedule and early dismissal this week of 1:15 pm. The PCHS afternoon bus will be leaving at 1:45 pm beginning Wednesday, June 2.

During final examinations, our usual cafeteria service is suspended. Lunch on these days, **Wednesday, June 2, 2021**, and **Thursday, June 3, 2021**, will only be available by advanced order. No other food will be served on these days. The **Deadline** for online orders is **Tuesday, June 1, 2021**. The cost will be \$5.00 per meal.
