Thursday, July 22 from 5:30 pm – 7:00 pm

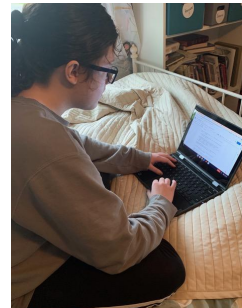
Friday, July 23 from 10:00 am – 6:00 pm
