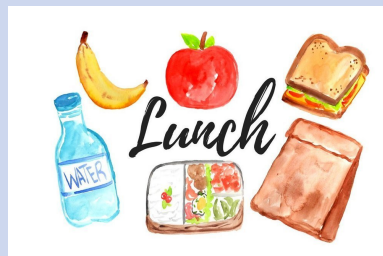
Showdown Day, Snacks, and Dismissal on Friday. Friday is a noon dismissal. Students are reminded that unless they have athletics or are using after-school supervision services, students should be off school grounds by 12:45 PM on Friday. Friday is our “infamous” Junior/Senior Showdown” and while there will be no lunch service, there will be snacks available for \$1 during the event. Also, the dances will be recorded and uploaded to our Youtube channel for our parents to view.

DLD for ALL students, Monday, September 20.

A reminder that Monday is a Digital Learning Day (DLD). All students will attend school virtually from home. They will be expected to attend homeroom as usual at 7:45 AM for prayer, pledge, and announcements. They will be expected to enter each class on time. We will follow the regular schedule for the day with three minutes between classes, students need to be on time for each class. Tardiness will result in a demerit. Students are expected to be in their regular Monday-Friday dress code which would include either their uniform polo or their polo and PC Spirit Wear or a sweater or their PC fleece. T-shirts, hats, etc. are not allowed. If students are not in appropriate dress, they could receive demerits from each teacher on Monday. Additionally, students must conduct themselves from either a desk or a table. Students should not be on couches, lounge chairs, etc. Finally, all students must have their cameras on their faces--not pointed to the ceiling or the top of their heads. Just like a regular day in school, students are expected to take ownership of their learning--requiring focus, organization, and maturity



Lunch Drop-off. Parents/Guardians, if you or a family member is bringing your student a lunch they need to have it here **NO LATER THAN 11:00!** Students should not be eating in their 3rd Block class.

announcements AND review the Club And Activity Calendar that has been shared with all students.

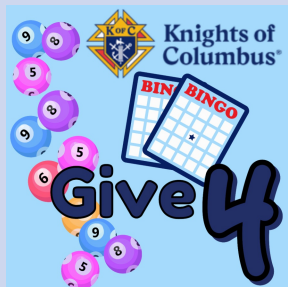
