When you buy your books from the Book Sale, you are helping to support Home and School. **Proceeds are used to provide parties, events, and celebrations throughout the year for students and faculty.**

\*Great opportunity to purchase your student's textbooks and sell your books from previous terms!

\*There is only one book sale each year so if financially possible, consider purchasing your books for the year!

\*Student class schedules will be provided prior to the Book Sale

\*Used uniforms, new ties, and Chromebook cases are also available for purchase.

\*Cash, Credit Cards and Checks are all accepted. A \$35.00 fee is assessed for returned checks, and there is a small service charge for credit card transactions.

\*The Home and School Association takes a 35% commission from all sales.

# How the Book Sale Works

## DO YOU HAVE BOOKS TO SELL?

\*We will accept textbooks, workbooks that have not been written in, and AP Test preparation books for sale.

\*A list of books that will **NOT BE** used and which we **WILL NOT ACCEPT** is included in this packet and will be available at all book check-in days.

1. Each book must have a post-it note ATTACHED to the inside front cover clearly printed with the NAME, ADDRESS, PHONE NUMBER of the seller, and the BOOK TITLE. Suggested size of post-it: 3x3 inches. PLEASE PRINT LEGIBLY!
2. Complete the provided MASTER LIST with the STUDENT'S NAME, PARENT/GUARDIAN'S TITLE. List one book per line. Please DO NOT put multiple copies of the same book on the same line. *Checks will be made payable to the parent unless otherwise authorized by the parent or if you are a host parent to an international student.* Read the disclosure statement in this packet and initial in the space provided on the Master List.
3. Drop your books off at the designated date and time; Home and School will price it and put it out the day of the Book Sale.
4. Your MasterList and books will be checked by a volunteer upon drop off. Please do not just leave your books without them being checked in.
5. A check will be mailed to you, along with your Master List and post-it notes, in a prepaid envelope provided by the Home and School Association approximately one month after the Book Sale day. Please remember this check will reflect the 35% commission taken by the Home and School Association.
6. Return to pick up any unsold books on either August 10th from 10:00 AM-12:00 PM or August 16th from 4:00-6:00 PM. Unsold books that are not picked up become the property of Home and School after 6:00 PM on August 16 unless other arrangements have been made.

## **Disclosure**

Peninsula Catholic High School and the Home and School Association will not be responsible for lost items or if the post-it note falls off the book.

**Unsold books must be picked up August 10<sup>th</sup> between 10:00 AM and 12:00 noon or August 16<sup>th</sup> between 4:00 PM and 6:00 PM.**

Unclaimed books will become the property of Peninsula Catholic Home and School Association after 6:00 PM on August 16, 2022.

After August 16<sup>th</sup>, post-it notes are removed from the books. Thus, there is no way to determine to whom an unsold item belongs.

**All proceeds from the sale will benefit the Peninsula Catholic Home and School Association.**
