How the Book Sale Works

DO YOU HAVE BOOKS TO SELL?

*We will accept textbooks, workbooks that have not been written in, and AP Test preparation books for sale.

*A list of books that will **NOT BE** used and which we **WILL NOT ACCEPT** is included in this packet and will be available at all book check-in days.

- 1. Each book must have a post-it note ATTACHED to the inside front cover clearly printed with the NAME, ADDRESS, PHONE NUMBER of the seller, and the BOOK TITLE. Suggested size of post-it: 3x3 inches. PLEASE PRINT LEGIBLY!
- Complete the provided MASTER LIST with the STUDENT'S NAME, PARENT/GUARDIAN'S TITLE. List one book per line. Please DO NOT put multiple copies of the same book on the same line. Checks will be made payable to the parent unless otherwise authorized by the parent or if you are a host parent to an international student. Read the disclosure statement in this packet and initial in the space provided on the Master List.
- 3. Drop your books off at the designated date and time; Home and School will price it and put it out the day of the Book Sale.
- 4. Your MasterList and books will be checked by a volunteer upon drop off. Please do not just leave your books without them being checked in.
- 5. A check will be mailed to you, along with your Master List and post-it notes, in a prepaid envelope provided by the Home and School Association approximately one month after the Book Sale day. Please remember this check will reflect the 35% commission taken by the Home and School Association.
- Return to pick up any unsold books on either August 10th from 10:00 AM-12:00 PM or August 16th from 4:00-6:00 PM. Unsold books that are not picked up become the property of Home and School after 6:00 PM on August 16 unless other arrangements have been made.

Disclosure

Peninsula Catholic High School and the Home and School Association will not be responsible for lost items or if the post-it note falls off the book.

Unsold books must be picked up August 10th between 10:00 AM and 12:00 noon or August 16th between 4:00 PM and 6:00 PM.

Unclaimed books will become the property of Peninsula Catholic Home and School Association after 6:00 PM on August 16, 2022.

After August 16th, post-it notes are removed from the books. Thus, there is no way to determine to whom an unsold item belongs.
